

Cookies Policy

The Communicating Astronomy with the Public Journal (hereafter "CAPjournal" or "CAPj") is operated by the International Astronomical Union's Office for Astronomy Outreach (hereafter "IAU OAO" or "OAO"). It is hosted on the website https://capjournal.org (hereafter the "Website"). CAPjournal is committed to protecting the privacy of its readers, editors and reviewers (the "users"). Note that the Website is not intended for children under the age of 16. In this document, "you" or "your" refers to you as a user of the Website (e.g., visiting, submitting an article, reviewing or editing an article, and interacting with and contacting the IAU OAO and CAPjournal via services on the Website). The Website uses cookies to enhance the browsing experience, display content in the appropriate language, and facilitate user interactions through forms. This policy explains what cookies the OAO uses and how users can manage them.

1. What are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files stored in a user's browser when visiting a website. They help remember information such as language preferences or session status.

2. Types of Cookies Used on the Website

- **Necessary cookies:** essential for the website to function properly (e.g., language selection, form submission).
- Location cookies: used to detect your region and show translated content accordingly.
- Functional cookies: remember your browsing preferences.

3. Third-Party Cookies

The Website **does not use** analytics or advertising cookies. Only technical cookies related to language and form functionalities are in place.

4. Managing Cookies

Cookies are stored on the user's computer and transmitted to the Website. Thus, you can configure your browser to allow, limit, block, or delete cookies. If cookies are deactivated for the
