

Terms and Conditions

The Communicating Astronomy with the Public Journal (hereafter "CAPjournal" or "CAPj") is operated by the International Astronomical Union's Office for Astronomy Outreach (hereafter "IAU OAO" or "OAO"). It is hosted on the website <u>https://capjournal.org</u> (hereafter the "Website"). CAPjournal is committed to protecting the privacy of its readers, editors and reviewers (the "users"). Note that the Website is not intended for children under the age of 16. In this document, "you" or "your" refers to you as a user of the Website (e.g., visiting, submitting an article, reviewing or editing an article, and interacting with and contacting the IAU OAO and CAPjournal via services on the Website). The Website uses cookies to enhance the browsing experience, display content in the appropriate language, and facilitate user interactions through forms. This policy explains what cookies the OAO uses and how users can manage them.

Unless specified otherwise, all materials published on the CAPjournal website are protected by a CC-BY 4.0 International copyright and owned by the IAU OAO or the party credited as the material provider. Users may reuse content under the terms of the license with appropriate attribution.

Appeals must be made in writing within 30 days of the decision and include a detailed rationale.

The CAPjournal follows international standards of ethical publishing, including guidelines from the <u>Committee on Publication Ethics</u> (COPE). All appeals and complaints are reviewed by the Editorial Board and, when necessary, may be escalated to the IAU Office for Astronomy Outreach for independent assessment.

All decisions following the appeal are final.

5. Third Party Links

The OAO does not share your personal data with third parties, except when necessary for technical functionality (such as automatic language translation, region detection, or email communications), when the OAO has explicit consent from you, or when required by law. For example, when you subscribe to our newsletter, your name and email address are processed through Mailchimp. As Mailchimp is based outside the European Union, your data may be transferred internationally. The OAO ensures appropriate safeguards are in place, including Standard Contractual Clauses approved by the European Commission.
